For the importation of Guinea Pigs into Curaçao, the animal must be accompanied by an Official International Health Certificate issued and endorsed by the official government veterinarian and signed by a certified veterinarian, with a validity of not older than 2 (two) weeks, attesting the following:

- The animals do not proceed from a zone or compartment that is under quarantine
- The animals are free of internal parasites. Therefore, they should be treated with a registered insecticide within 14 days prior to departure (mention the date, the time and the product used on the health certificate).
- The animals are free of *Chlamydia caviae* and therefore are tested and/or treated with a registered medicine
- The animals are transported according to IATA regulations.

The health certificate may be emailed for approval for entry at info.uovz@gobiernu.cw.
